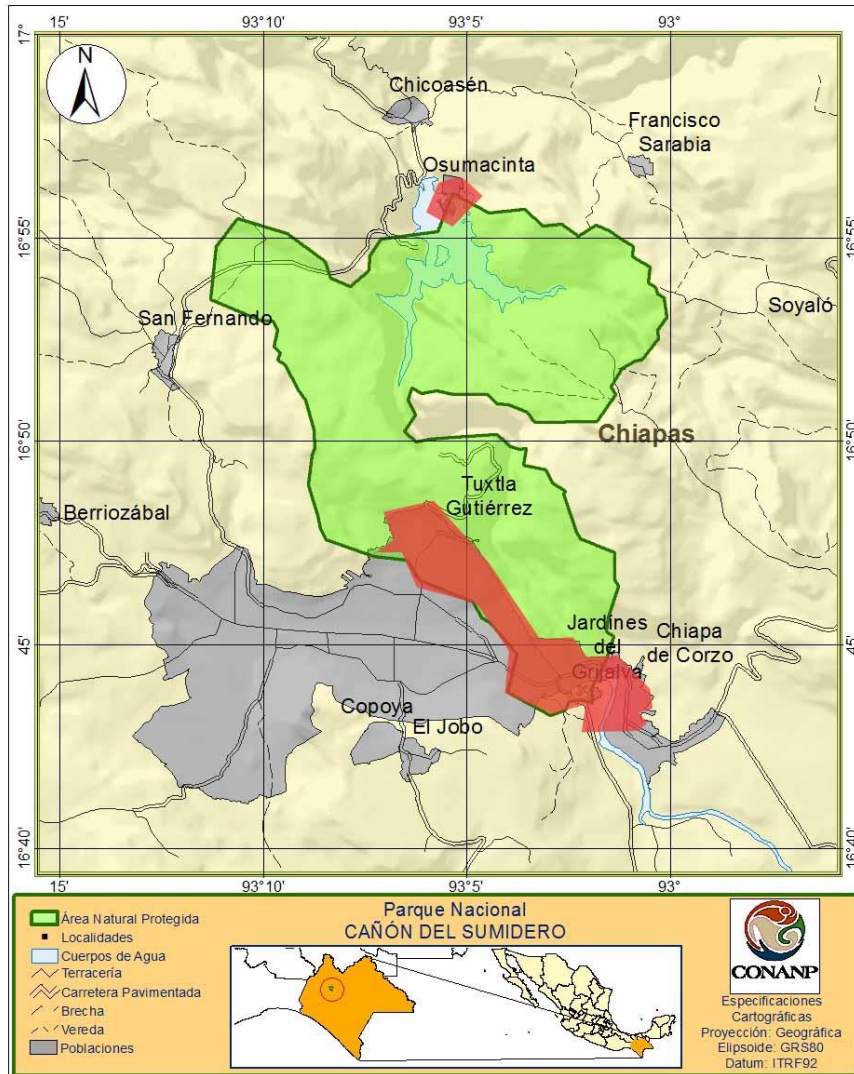

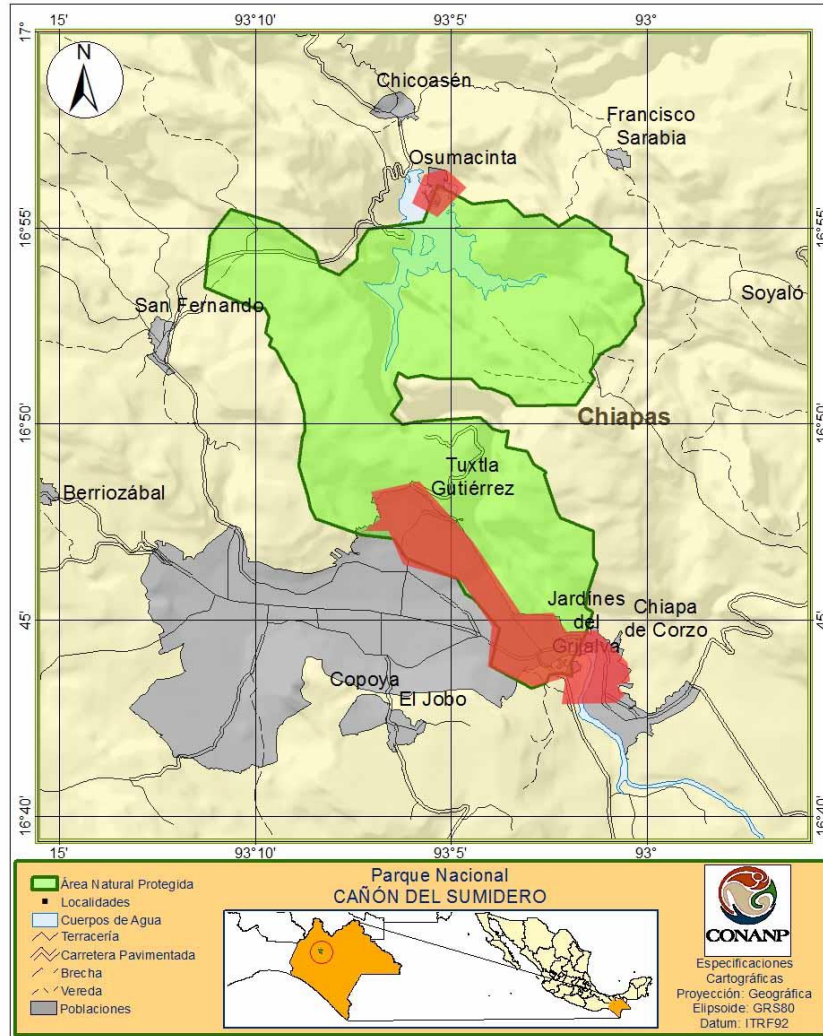
# Sumidero Canyon National Park

- Water contamination



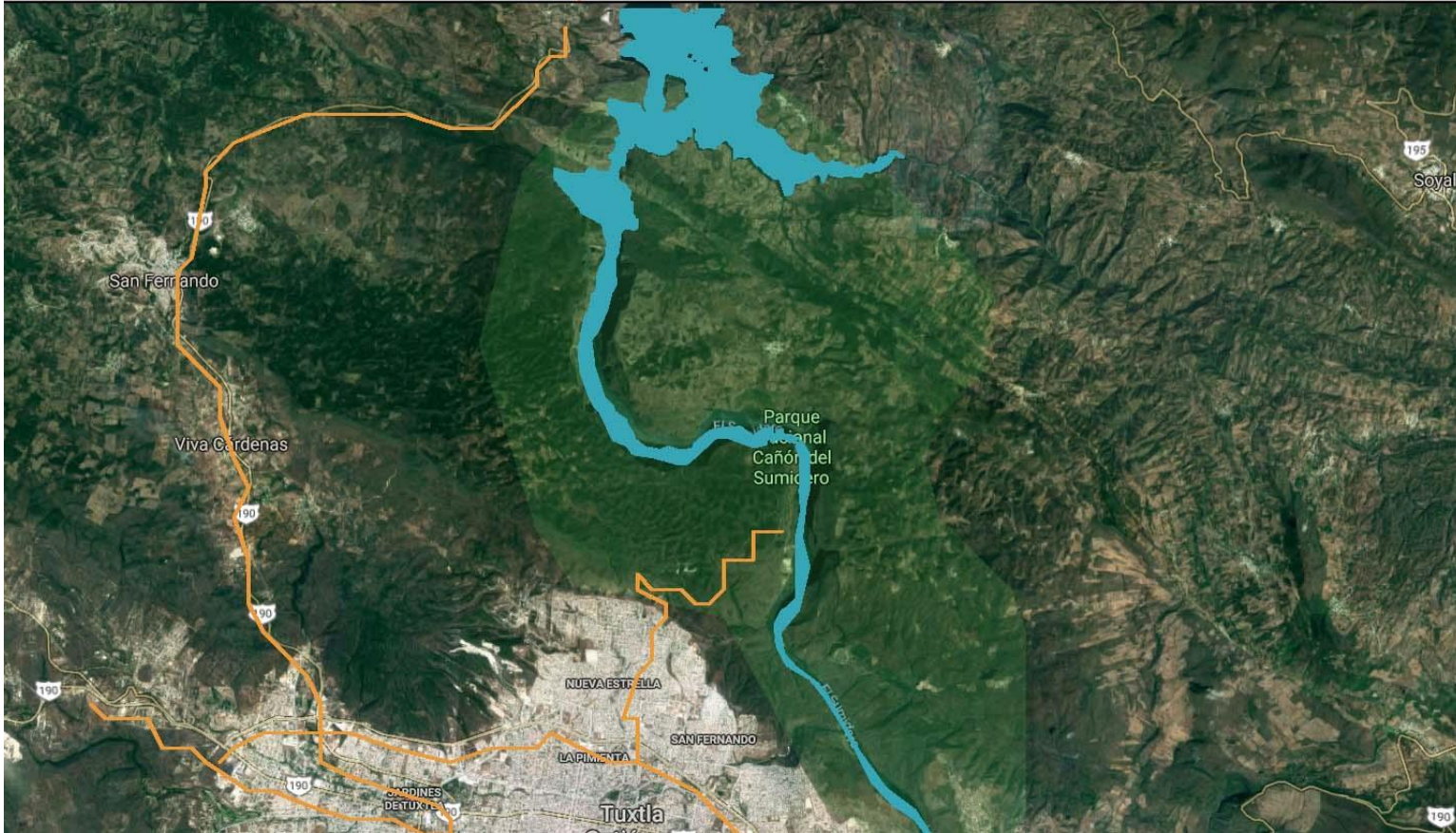

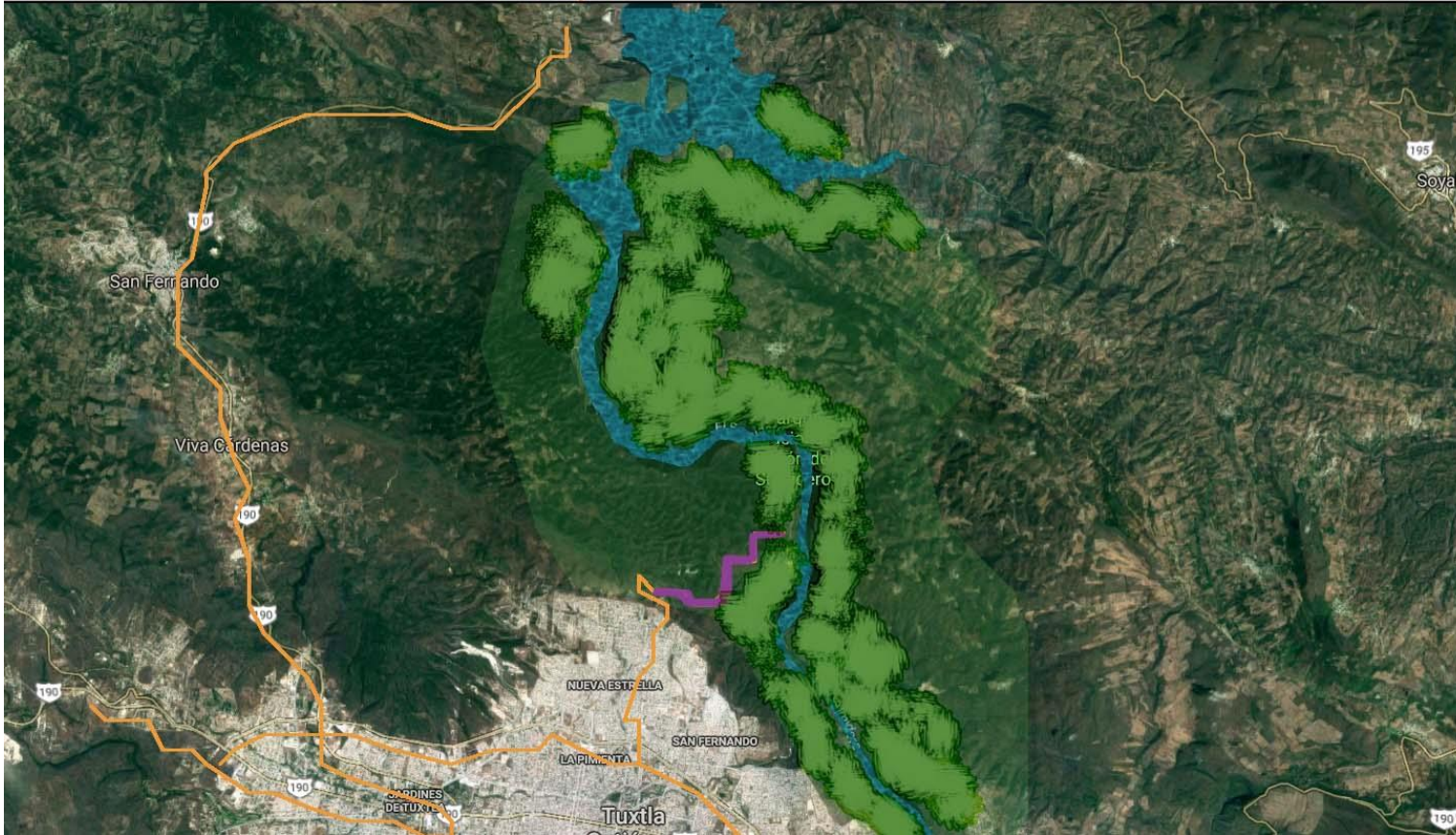

# What could be your strategy for improvement?



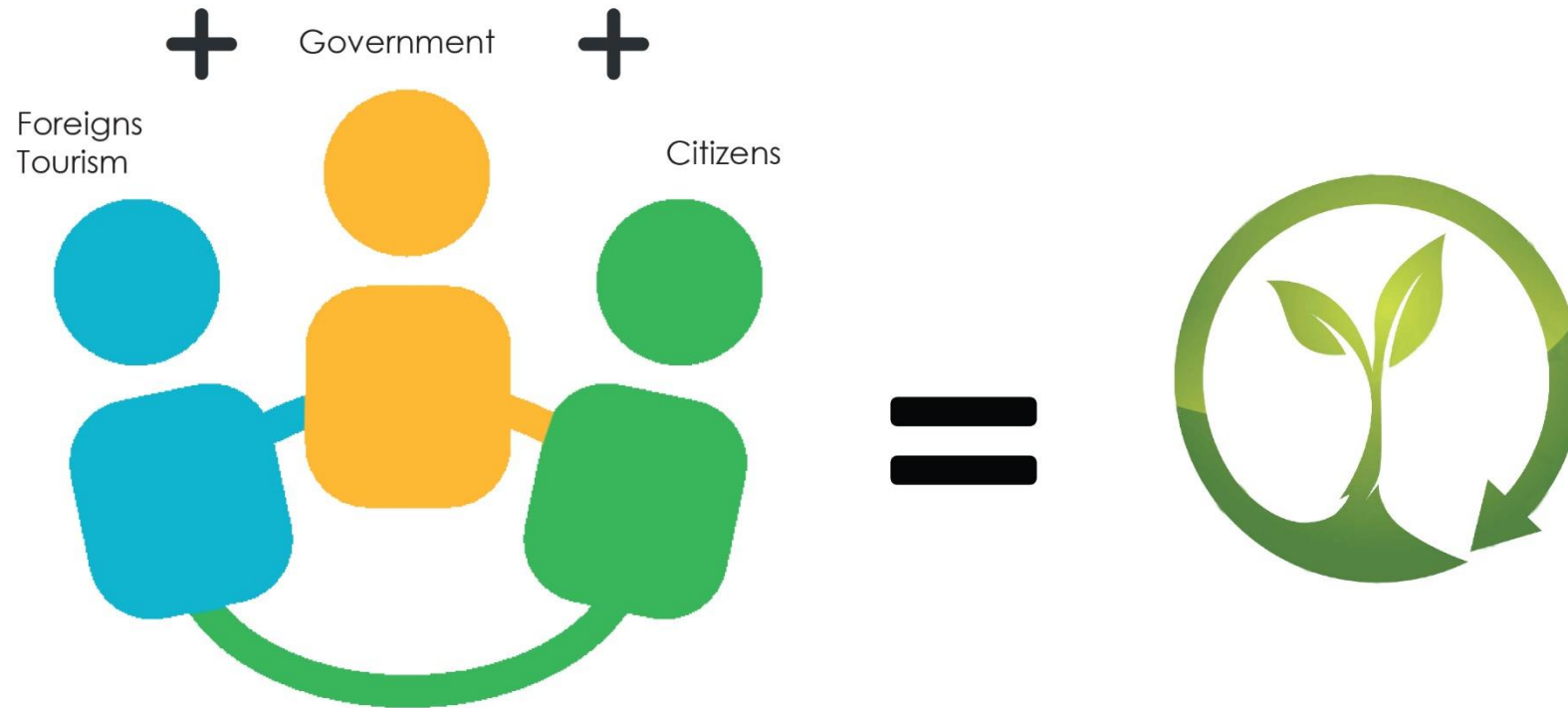
- Design to the protection of this area.
