
As a follow up of our discussion in the last meeting, there are two alternatives for the course end of February – end of April 2026. One more focused on the building blocks, one focused on developing a community of practice / research where participants work on a selected building block.



## Alternative A. Sessions on the building blocks, without any assignment

We could follow the same sequence but now we might focus more on the building blocks of agroecological urbanism, because these offer a good basis for participants to engage in transformative action. Each session may consist of a short theoretical introduction, a case study relating to the building block and then time for Q&A. We only leave out the Healthy Soils.

The course looks like this:



## Alternative B. First intro and then continue working as a CoP on an assignment.

The participants need to select a building block when <u>registering</u> for the course. The 3 last sessions have lower frequency so participants can work on their project / assignment. People can also only follow the first 4 sessions in a passive mode. Depending on the number of participants that opted for a BB we form groups, and each group needs a tutor.
